JPH APPENDIX 2 COMPETITION PLAN AND RANKING

1. JPIL Invitational

1.1. U16

- 1.1.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.1.2. Ranking in a pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.1.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

1.2. U19

- 1.2.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.2.2. Ranking in a pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.2.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

2. JPIL U14

- 2.1. There will be two (2) pools of ten (10) teams.
- 2.2. Each team will also play one (1) additional “friendly” match against one (1) team from the other pool. The result of this match will not count towards pool play competition and the statistics will not be recorded, however failure to play in this match will be addressed as according to the Disqualification rules for failure to complete a match during pool play.
- 2.3. Ranking in a pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 2.4. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the two-pool competition with the top two (2) teams in each pool competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

3. JPI Tournament

3.1. U14

- 3.1.1. There will be one (1) pool of six (6) teams who play each other once.
- 3.1.2. Final ranking is determined according to Regulation 1.7

3.2. U16

- 3.2.1. There will be one (1) pool of seven (7) teams who play each other once.
- 3.2.2. Final ranking is determined according to Regulation 1.7

3.3. U19

- 3.3.1. There will be two (2) pools of five (5) teams.
- 3.3.2. Ranking in a pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7.
- 3.3.3. Final classification matches played on the Championship date as follows:
