## JPH APPENDIX 2 COMPETITION PLAN AND RANKING

### 1. JPIL Invitational

#### 1.1. U16

- 1.1.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.1.2. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.1.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

#### 1.2. U19

- 1.2.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.2.2. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.2.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

### 2. JPIL U14

#### 2.1. There will be two (2) pools of eight (8) – “Pool A” & “Pool B”

- 2.1.1. Teams play each team within their pool once.
- 2.1.2. Teams are ranked within their respective pools according to Regulation 1.7

#### 2.2. After Pool A & Pool B play described in 2.1.1 is complete, two (2) new crossover pools (C & D) are created based on rankings in 2.1.2.

- 2.2.1. The top 4 teams from Pool A will play the top 4 teams from Pool B in “Pool C”
- 2.2.2. The bottom 4 teams from Pool A will play the bottom 4 teams from Pool B in “Pool D”
- 2.2.3. Teams are ranked within their respective pools C & D according to Regulation 1.7

#### 3.2. U19

- 3.2.1. There will be two (2) pools of five (5) teams.
- 3.2.2. Teams are ranked within their respective pools according to Regulation 1.7
- 3.2.3. Final classification matches played on the Championship date as follows:

#### 4.1. U14

- 4.1.1. There will be two (2) pools of four (4) teams who play each other once.
- 4.1.2. Teams are ranked within their respective pools according to Regulation 1.7
- 4.1.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top two (2) teams in each pool competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

#### 4.2. U16

- 4.2.1. There will be three (3) pools of four (4) teams who play each other once.
- 4.2.2. After pool play, all 12 teams are ranked according to Regulation 1.7 and will be labeled as Pool C.
- 4.2.3. Crossover and final classification matches played on the Championship date as follows:
  - 4.2.3.1. The first ranked teams from each pool play in a 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> classification pool
  - 4.2.3.2. The second ranked teams from each pool play in a 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> classification pool
  - 4.2.3.3. The third ranked teams from each pool play in a 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> classification pool
- 4.2.4. Teams are ranked within their respective classification pools according to Regulation 1.7.

#### 4.3. U19

- 4.3.1. There will be three (3) pools of four (4) teams who play each other once.
- 4.3.2. After pool play, all 12 teams are ranked according to Regulation 1.7 and will be labeled as Pool C.
- 4.3.3. Crossover and final classification matches played on the Championship date as follows:
  - 4.3.3.1. The first ranked teams from each pool play in a 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> classification pool
  - 4.3.3.2. The second ranked teams from each pool play in a 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> classification pool
  - 4.3.3.3. The third ranked teams from each pool play in a 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> classification pool
- 4.3.4. Teams are ranked within their respective classification pools according to Regulation 1.7.
