UM Report

- Complete a UM report by Wednesday after each competition date
- You may submit via Google Sheets or Email/Excel spreadsheet
- To submit a new report each week, please COPY the UM Report tab in Google Sheets and complete a new sheet

Addressing spectator misconduct

- Consider whether Umpires are just being sensitive or if there is legitimate misconduct
 - If the Umpires are sensitive or new, coach them that passionate fans are important to sport and they need to focus on the match in front of them and trust there is a process to protect them
 - If there is legitimate fan misconduct, immediately bring it to the attention of the on-site Technical Delegate (TD) to manage
- Include a detailed report of the fan misconduct in your weekly UM report

Should you have any concerns regarding an umpire or other misconduct

- Discuss the incident/s with Offender/Umpire
- Document the incident and discussion in UM Report. Include:
 - Name of the umpire
 - What, if any, further action do you recommend
 - No action
 - Official Reprimand
 - Remove from future use
 - Any other suggested follow up/action
 - Comments on umpires in UM reports will be saved in separate database by DoU for potential future reference
- DoU will review and advise re: official decision
