1. JPIL Invitational

1.1. U16

- 1.1.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.1.2. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.1.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

1.2. U19

- 1.2.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 1.2.2. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 1.2.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition.

2. JPIL U14

- 2.1. There will be one (1) pool of twelve (12) teams who play each other once.
- 2.2. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 2.3. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top four (4) teams competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition

3. JPI Tournament 2 (January 22/23)

3.1. U14

- 3.1.1. There will be one (1) pool of seven (7) teams who play each other once.
- 3.1.2. Teams are ranked within the pool according to Regulation 1.7
- 3.1.3. At the end of pool play, the Team with the most points will be the Champion.

3.2. U16

- 3.2.1. There will be two (2) pools, one pool of four (4) and one pool of three (3) teams.
- 3.2.2. Teams play each team within their pool once.
- 3.2.3. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 3.2.4. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top (2) teams in each pool competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition

3.3. U19

- 3.3.1. There will be two (2) pools of five (5) teams.
- 3.3.2. Teams play each team within their pool once.
- 3.3.3. Ranking in the pool is determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 3.3.4. Crossover and final classification matches will be played on the Championship date after the pool competition with the top (2) teams in each pool competing for the Championship via classification play-off competition and the remaining teams competing for final ranking via classification play-off competition
