

## **Directions to the Aviator Sports and Recreation Complex**

**Located on Flatbush Avenue, Just South of Belt Parkway, Exit 11S. 5 Floyd Bennett Field, 3159 Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn, NY 11234**

### **Driving Directions from South**

- Take the NJ Turnpike North (I95 N) – toward New York
- Merge onto 278 East / Verrazano Narrows Bridge – via Exit 13
- Continue towards Verrazano Bridge
- Merge left onto Belt Pkwy East
- Take Exit 11S off the Belt Parkway – Flatbush Ave. South – towards Rockaways

### **For get to Main Entrance and parking:**

- **Go South on Flatbush Avenue. (You will see Aviator's fields on left, but the last entrance to Floyd Bennett Field is still another ¾ of a mile ahead.)**
- **Make left at the last traffic light (just before the toll bridge) to enter Floyd Bennett Field.**
- **You will pass a guard house.**
- **Take first left. You are now heading north on a former runway, parallel to Flatbush Ave.**

### **Driving Directions from North**

- Take the NJ Turnpike North (I95 S/N)
- Merge onto 678 S via Exit 10 – toward Whitestone Bridge
- Take Exit 1W toward Verrazano Bridge / Belt Pkwy West
- Turn slight right onto N Conduit Ave
- Merge onto Belt Pkwy W. towards Verrazano Bridge
- Take Exit 11S off the Belt Parkway – Flatbush Ave. South – towards Rockaways

### **Driving Directions from Lower Manhattan:**

Take the Battery Tunnel – exit 2- toward 278/Brooklyn (Westbound)

- Left hand merge onto the Belt Parkway (East)
- Take Exit 11S off the Belt Parkway – Flatbush Ave. South – towards the Rockaways.

## **MTA Transit – Subway & Buses**

**NOTE:** The # 2 train operates all hours.

- Take the # 2 train to the Flatbush Avenue/Brooklyn College station (last stop)
- Take the Q35 bus one block from the train station – Flatbush Ave. between Nostrand Avenue and Avenue H
- Request the bus to stop across from Aviator Sports and Recreation at Floyd Bennett Field
- Walk across the road, enter the open gate by the Ryan Visitor Center
